

**PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC HEARING AND  
REGULAR SESSION  
OF WESTLAKE CITY COUNCIL  
JANUARY 17, 2008**

Public hearing was called to order by President of Council Michael F. Killeen at 8:15 p.m. in accordance with Article III, Section 13, of the Westlake City Charter and legal notice published in the Westlife on January 9, 2008, and January 16, 2008, regarding the following legislation:

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-174:           AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FOOTNOTE (c) OF SECTION 1218.03 OF THE ZONING CODE IN ORDER TO PERMIT OFFICE USE BY CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT IN THE INDUSTRIAL ZONED AREAS NORTH OF I-90 FROM CLAGUE ROAD TO COLUMBIA ROAD BETWEEN SPERRY ROAD AND THE NORTH CORPORATE LINE.
