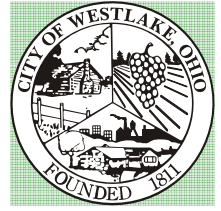

HUMUS & WOOD CHIPS
PRICING INFORMATION
Commercial or Large Quantity Purchases



Due to current increased demand for materials and the need to maintain stock for residents, the City of Westlake retains the right to limit and/or stop the pick-up of materials at any time if stock piles are down. The current limit for Commercial or Large Quantity Purchases will be 250 yards per month – or – 1000 yards per season. These numbers can/will be adjusted towards end of season if supplies allow.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS
OF CHAPTER 955 “HUMUS/MULCH SALES” OF
THE STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICE
CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Service and the Mayor have recommended that Council consider amending various Sections of Chapter 955 “Humus/Mulch Sales” of the Streets, Utilities, and Service Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Chapter 955 “Humus/Mulch Sales” of the Streets, Utilities, and Service Code, be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

“CHAPTER 955
Humus/Wood Chip ~~Mulch~~ Sales

955.01 Authority.

955.02 Fee schedule.

955.01 AUTHORITY.

The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to provide for sale the products generated by the City of Westlake Composting Facility ~~Reeyeling Center~~ in accordance with the fee schedule established herein and shall have the authority to limit the quantity sold to any one account per month or per season based on product available on site.

955.02 FEE SCHEDULE.

The fee schedule for the sale of products generated by the City of Westlake Composting Facility ~~Reeyeling Center~~ shall be as follows:

Section 2: That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake.

Section 5: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend regulations on Humus/Mulch Sales, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
