

## **NEVER Get Between Snow Plows Traveling Together**

Trucks often travel in groups to clear entire roadways. Sudden lane shifts are common because of medians and turn lanes.

Traveling along side these groups is very dangerous.

### **Watch out for Blind Spots**

Plowing city streets requires frequent backing of the truck. The plow driver's field of view is limited. If you can't see the plow's side mirrors, the driver can't see you. Stay two or three car lengths behind the plow.

### **Ice & Snow... Take it Slow**

Snow plows travel well below the posted speed limit. Be patient. Try not to pass the plow. Watch for sudden stops or turns.

### **Beware of Snow Clouds**

Snow plows often create clouds as they clear the roads. These snow clouds can reduce your ability to see.
