## Admission Regulations

1. Season Passes are non-transferable. Attempts to transfer will result in suspension at the discretion of the pool manager. A \$5.00 replacement fee is charged for lost cards.
2. A season pass entitles the holder to all open swimming sessions at the pool.
3. An ADULT (18 years of age and older) MUST accompany children under the age of 10. There must be one adult for every 6 children under the age of 10.
4. Food, drinks and coolers are NOT ALLOWED in the POOL AREA/DECK without a permit. Coolers must be checked at the front desk (no charge) and taken back out into the park for consumption.
5. In-Out privileges are provided. See Cashier to have your hand stamped.

## Course Descriptions

**TINY TOTS:** Designed for 3-5 year olds with a 4-1 teacher ratio. Children are grouped by skill level the first day of class.

**LEVEL 1:** For students just starting out in the Learn to Swim program. Students learn basic aquatic skills including supported floating, bubble blowing & exploring alternating arm & leg action on their front & back.

**LEVEL 2:** Students will build on the skills learned in Level 1 & will begin to float without support, bob rhythmically, & combine arm & leg action on their front & back for 15 ft. unsupported.

**LEVEL 3:** Students will build on the skills learned in Level 2 & will begin to learn to coordinate the front & back crawl for 15 yards & are introduced to elements of the butterfly & the fundamentals of treading water.

**LEVEL 4:** Students will build on the skills learned earlier & begin to increase their stroke endurance by swimming longer distances. Students will continue to work on elements of the butterfly & elementary backstroke, breaststroke & sidestroke are introduced.

**LEVEL 5:** Students in this level refine their performance in all strokes & also work on increasing their swimming distance. Flip turns are also introduced.

**LEVEL 6:** This course is designed for children who are working toward stroke proficiency. Stroke work and endurance are emphasized. Upon completion of program, participants will be ready to join a swim team.

American Red Cross Guard Start: Lifeguarding Tomorrow is a program designed to guide youth to the American Red Cross lifeguarding program to build a foundation of knowledge, attitudes and skills for future lifeguards. The Guard Start program is designed for youth 11 years old, or who have completed the 5<sup>th</sup> grade, through 14 years old. Before entering the program, participants must demonstrate these skills:

Swim the front crawl for 25 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side, tread water for 1 minute using both arms and legs and submerge and swim a distance of 10 feet underwater. This is a great class for any one who has finished Learn to Swim Levels 6. Max - 15.

## Pool Entrance Rules

1. Enter through the front of the bathhouse **ONLY**. Patrons must show ID cards or pay daily admission fee. Westlake Recreation Center members **MUST** present their membership card at time of admission to receive discounted rate. Residents must show proof of residency to receive the resident rate.
2. Proper swimming attire is required. Spandex/ Lycra suits are acceptable cover up material. **NO T-shirts!** Swimsuits with floats inside of them and water wings are permitted. A parent has to be within arms length of that child. Thong suits are not permitted. Suits must be worn in the style in which they were intended. Suits may not be removed for sunbathing.
3. All swimmers are encouraged to take a hot, soapy shower before leaving the bathhouse and entering the pool.
4. No personal items should be left in the locker rooms. Management cannot assume responsibility for lost items. Lockers are available for a small fee.
5. The following are Prohibited: Alcohol, any object made partly or wholly of glass, food of any type (picnic baskets & coolers must be left at the front desk), and gum.

# GENERAL POOL INFORMATION



1. Aqua Slides: You **MUST** be at least 48" tall to use the slide. Riders must be lying down in a feet first position with legs crossed and arms across chest. Exit pool immediately after ride.
2. These items are prohibited in the pool : lifejackets or other flotation devices, t-shirts, watches, bracelets, necklaces, long earrings and goggles.
3. Patrons are not permitted to ride with children in laps.
4. Young children are not allowed in the diving well or 5 foot section unless they can swim the width of the pool unassisted.
5. The inclined entrance ramp is used to enter and exit the water only. No playing, running or sunbathing will be permitted on this inclined area.
6. Chaise lounges are for adults 18 & over **ONLY** when the pool is crowded.
7. One-piece swimming masks, snorkels or fins are not permitted. **ONLY** Flexible goggles that cover the eyes are permitted.
8. Only nerf balls are permitted.
9. Parents cannot hold their kids around their necks and no piggybacks.
10. Non-toilet trained children must wear swim diapers. Each hour there will be a fifteen-minute rest period at a quarter of an hour. All children must leave the pool. Adults ages 18 and over and children under the age of 6 accompanied by a parent are permitted to swim during rest periods. Children must be within an arm's length of the adult.
11. Patrons may not visit with the guards while they are on duty.
12. Divers:
  - a. There is **NO DIVING** from the deck in the main pool. Only diving as a water entry is permitted in diving well.
  - b. All dives must be in the forward position.
  - c. Only one diver on the board at a time. Divers must jump straight off the board.
  - d. Divers must swim directly to the nearest ladder after entering the water.
  - e. No one is permitted to catch anyone going off the boards.
13. Never jump over, upon or near a swimmer in the water.
12. Adults may hold small children. No other doubling up is permitted.
13. Improper conduct or profane language or gestures are forbidden.

## Inclement Weather

1. Peterson Pool **WILL NOT OPEN** if the temperature at pool opening is below 68 degrees.
2. The pool will close at the discretion of the management if the weather warrants or the temperature falls below 68 degrees.
3. Refunds or rainchecks will **NOT** be issued if the pool closes because of inclement weather or if patrons who are asked to leave the pool because of multiple or flagrant rule violations.

## Sun Shade Structures

These structures are provided so patrons may seek shelter from the hot mid-day sun. Infants and/or children may not be left unattended in the structures.

## Tot Pool

1. The tot pool is for children 6 years of age and under **ONLY**. Non-toilet trained children must wear a swim diaper.
2. These children **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED** by an **ADULT IN ATTENDANCE** at all times.
3. The tot pool will remain open during rest period for children 6 years of age and under only accompanied by an adult.

## Concession Area

Smoking is permitted outside the pool fence only. Food purchased from the concession stand may be eaten in the adjacent concession area only - no other area of the pool. Picnic tables in the concession area cannot be reserved. Food brought to the pool area must be checked in at the front desk and taken out into the park for consumption.

## Parking

1. Patrons should use the parking lot east of the pool.
2. **DO NOT** park in the pool service drive or along the road.
3. Children should be dropped off and picked up at the entrance to the service drive. **DO NOT** drive up the service drive to drop off or pick up unless they are handicapped.
4. Overflow parking is located on the north side of the Clague Road entrance to the park.
