



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-89:**

**REDLINED  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
SUBSECTION 167.09(b) OF CHAPTER 167,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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**WHEREAS**, upon the recommendation of the Mayor, Council desires to amend Subsection 167.09(b) as to the City’s Wellness Program for Recreation Center employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1:** That Subsection 167.09(b) of Chapter 167 entitled “Employees Generally” be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

**“167.09 HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE.**

(b) Wellness Program: In order to promote wellness among City employees, and members of their families so as to encourage a healthier work force, all Full-Time employees identified in paragraph (a) above **and all Part-Time Recreation Center employees** shall be entitled to join the Westlake Recreation Center at a fifty percent (50%) discount off the regular established resident rates. **Additionally, all Full-Time Recreation Center employees will be entitled to receive a free individual membership to the Recreation Center to be used only during the course of their employment at the Recreation Center.**”

**Section 2:** That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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**Section 4:** That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Recreation Department, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
