May 5—Marry Me—2022

A betrayed pop star, slated to marry her pop star fiancé on stage, instead marries a stranger from the audience - a high school math teacher. Against the odds, their sham relationship develops into something real but can their love survive the limelight? Romance/Comedy. PG-13 for some language and suggestive material. 21hour 52 minutes.

May 12 – House of Gucci—2021

House of Gucci' is inspired by the shocking true story of the family behind the Italian fashion empire. When Patrizia Reggiani, an outsider from humble beginnings, marries into the Gucci family, her unbridled ambition begins to unravel the family legacy and triggers a reckless decades long spiral of betrayal, decadence, revenge, and ultimately...murder. May 19 – Finding You—2020

While studying abroad in Ireland, accomplished young musician Finley meets heartthrob movie star Beckett shooting his latest medieval fantasy blockbuster. Sparks fly between the unlikely couple who inspire each other to find the strength to be true to oneself. But when forces surrounding Beckett's stardom threaten to crush their dreams, Finley must decide what she is willing to risk for love. Romance/Drama PG for language and thematic elements. 1 hour 59minutes.

May 26 – The 39 Steps—2008

BBC's adaptation of John Buchan's thriller: Richard Hannay finds himself framed for a murder he didn't commit. Now he has to break a ruthless German espionage network to prove his innocence and, more importantly and patriotically, warn the admiralty that its plans have fallen to the enemy. Full of excitement, danger, fun and romance, The 39 Steps is a remarkable tale of an ordinary man who puts his country's interests before his own safety. Crime/Mystery. TV-PG for some thematic material. 1 hour 30 minutes.
