The Westlake Police Department is proud to offer the Community Police Academy to local residents and business persons.

The Academy will be held every Wednesday evening from 6:30—9:30 p.m. for twelve consecutive weeks beginning August 31 and ending November 26, 2022.

Participants learn directly from department personnel with special training in areas such as:

- * Patrol & Traffic Operations
- * Technological Advances in Law Enforcement
- * SWAT
- * Self Defense & Firearms
- * Criminal Scene Processing
- * WPD Drone Program

The goal of the Community Police Academy is to increase understanding between the community and the police department that serves it.

It is our hope to build a strong and mutually beneficial relationship for the future of OUR community.

Participants are encouraged to ask questions and express concerns. Class time includes sessions of role play that enact common police interactions, other hands on activities and a ride along session.

There is NO COST for attending the academy. Class size is limited to 20 participants.

Applications will be accepted until Friday, August 19, or until class is filled. All applicants meeting the listed requirements will be notified of their selection. A cross section of the community will be selected for each academy class.

At the conclusion of each academy program, a graduation ceremony is held. Family and friends are encouraged to attend.

Please note, the community police academy will NOT prepare you for a career in law enforcement and is NOT designed for persons pursuing a career in law enforcement.
