

2020 LEAF COLLECTION

Spring Leaf Collection

April 20 – 24 and April 27 – May 1

Fall Leaf Collection

October 19 – Early December (weather permitting)

LEAVES ONLY – do not mix branches or grass cuttings with leaves as this will plug machines and slow the collection process. Please remember to place leaves on the tree lawn and **not in the street.**

Addresses with leaves piles in the street will be reported to Westlake Police. Please do **NOT** park vehicles in front of leaf piles. If a vehicle is blocking a leaf pile, we will be unable to pick it up and you will have to wait until the next collection. Please keep catch basins in the street in front of your house clear by removing grass clippings, brush, and leaves that may collect there. This will help prevent flooding during heavy rains.

We will be updating this site on a daily basis so that residents can check to see when we will be picking up leaves in their area of the city. We generally go from route to route in numerical order. If you see on the Daily Update (below) that we are working on, or have just completed, a route that is shortly before your route, it would be advisable to get your leaves raked out as soon as possible.

Also bear in mind that the leaf crews work rain or shine. **It is not possible to come back to pick up leaves that were put out after we have passed your house.** If you do not want to wait for our leaf trucks to pick up in your area, you can bag your leaves for trash and Rumpke will pick them up on your regular collection day. LEAF COLLECTION DAILY UPDATE

Wednesday, October 28, 2020

Crews completed the remainder of Routes 1 & 2. They moved onto Routes 3 & 4 and completed the following: Route 3-completed everything **but** Dover between Hilliard to Center Ridge, Seneca, Hilliard between Dover to Crocker **north** side only. Route 4-completed everything **but** Hilliard Bradley West, Windsor Park Development, Hilliard Woods Development, Lincoln. One crew started on Route 5 at 2:50pm however did not complete any streets. Tomorrow, 10/29, crews will continue working on Routes 3, 4 & 5 then move onto Routes 6-8.

Tuesday, October 27, 2020

Crews completed the remainder of Routes 17-19 and Route 20. They moved on to Routes 1-4 and completed the following: Route 1- Forest Lake, Waterfall, Deer Run, Hunter's Creek, Turtle Creek, and Rocky Ridge. Route 2- Farmington and Johnston. Routes 3 and 4- nothing completed yet. Tomorrow, 10/28, crews will continue working on Routes 1-4. They will move on to Routes 5-8 if time allows.

Monday, October 26, 2020

Crews completed the remainder of Routes 14, 15, and 16. They also completed the majority of Route 17, except for Westwood (Walter East), and northbound Clague (Center Ridge South). They completed the majority of Route 18, except for Pebblebrook, Fox Run, Beaver Creek, Wingedfoot, Interlachen, and Quail Hollow. Only Arlington Row was completed on Route 19. Route 20 has not been started. Tomorrow, 11/27, crews should complete the remainder of Routes 17-19 and Route 20. They will move on to Routes 1-4 if time allows.

Friday, October 23, 2020

Crews completed the remainder of Route 11. Crews started working on Routes 13-16. Crews completed all of Route 13. On Route 14, crews completed Canterbury Rose south, Strawberry and Clark Parkway development. The majority of Route 15 is complete except the north side of Rustic Lane and Laura Ln. between Melibee to Rustic. On Route 16, crews completed Westwood between Columbia to Walter, Shiloh, Brantwood Development and Maple Ridge. Monday, 10/26, crews will finish Routes 14, 15 & 16 and then move on to Routes 17-20.

Thursday, October 22, 2020

Crews completed Routes 9, 10, and 12. The majority of Route 11 was completed, except Hilliard (Dover to Canterbury), Forest Pkwy., Maple Dr., Elmwood, Beechwood, Chestnut, Berkeley, and Sleepy Hollow. Tomorrow, 10/23, crews will complete Route 11 and move on to Routes 13-16.

Wednesday, October 21, 2020

Crews completed Jefferson and Adams on Route 5. They also completed Routes 7 and 8. Crews started on Route 9 and completed Point West development. Tomorrow, 10/22, crews will continue on Route 9 and move on to Routes 10-12.

Tuesday, October 20, 2020

Crews completed Routes 2, 3, 4, and 6. Crews also completed the majority of Route 5, except for Jefferson and Adams. Tomorrow, 10/21, crews should complete the remainder of Route 5 and Routes 7 and 8. They may move on to Routes 9-12 if time permits.

Monday, October 19, 2020

Crews completed Route 1 and 2 (except for the Savannah development). Tomorrow, 10/20, crews should complete the remainder of Route 2 and Routes 3, and 4.
